

Security Measures:

Please note: the visits take place in units in production. For yours and the workers' safety, it is essential to respect certain security measures in Cascades facilities.

- Hand washing upon entry is mandatory.
- Visits last around 1h15 to 1h30.
- Children under the age of 6 are not permitted in the workshops.
- The visit is not wheel-chair accessible.
- Those wearing a pacemaker or who have respiratory problems, people with a handicap and pregnant women are all permitted to enter, but with the understanding that they may encounter difficulties due to heat, sound, and smells that may be noxious.
- For security reasons, it will not be possible to go near certain machines or certain sectors of the factories. You must stay in the corridors provided for this purpose at all times.
- The wearing of protective eyewear is mandatory in all the shops. We will give one pair to each person, to be returned to your guide at the end of the visit.
- The wearing of earplugs is mandatory in all the shops. If you wear hearing aids, the wearing of earplugs is not mandatory, but we will ask you to turn down the volume on your devices or to turn them off completely.
- Closed shoes, therefore covering the toes and heels, are mandatory. Heels are not allowed in the factory.
- Hair (touching the shoulders and longer) should be tied back in a hair bun.
- It is also mandatory to remove all jewelry and to not use your cellphone at any time.
- Be advised that the temperatures in the factories may reach very high levels, especially when the temperature outside is elevated.
- You must stay with your guide for the duration of the visit. He or she will make sure that the visit goes smoothly and will be responsible for your safety in emergency situations.
- Drinking or eating in the factory will not be permitted.
- Photos are not permitted.
